* Bulletin 1508 is very prescriptive relative to the conducting of evaluations to determine eligibility or continued eligibility for special education services. The SUNS Center follows all requirements as outlined in Bulletin 1508 when conducting student evaluations. Bulletin 1508 requires that all evaluations be multidisciplinary in both assessment measures and evaluation team members and that the process be coordinated by an Evaluation Coordinator that meets state requirements for such a position. When The SUNS Center conducts an evaluation, there is a guarantee that all components are conducted with fidelity according to Bulletin 1508 and that the Evaluation Coordinator is qualified to serve in that position. In addition, The SUNS Center is able to provide evaluators in every discipline area including Academic, Behavior, Speech, Audiological, Occupational Therapy, Physical Therapy, Adapted Physical Education, Health, Psychological, Gifted, Talented in Music, Theatre and Visual Arts, Orientation and Mobility, and Assistive Technology. Bulletin 1508 requires the Evaluation Coordinator to ensure all necessary assessment components are conducted and that all data is analyzed and summarized in a multidisciplinary evaluation report. The SUNS Center makes these assurances.
